



The Health Data Coalition (HDC) is a physician-led data sharing initiative that encourages reflection and collaboration with colleagues and facilitates quality improvement in patient care though its application **HDC Discover**. It's funded by GPSC, and powered by the enthusiasm and dedication of a growing network of family physicians from across the province.

HDC's primary focus is to empower physicians and clinics to understand and use their data for practice improvement. **HDC Discover** also provides a means to share data, if you choose, that is relevant for Primary Care Networks (PCNs) and other initiatives.

Physicians and clinicians across BC have connected through HDC's technology, which provides comparative views of aggregate trends in primary care data.

- Track improvements in patient care over time with HDC Discover's automatic data transfer and reporting features.

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HDC is physician-led and physician-governed.

As a physician-led organization, privacy is central to HDC's trusted health provider network.

HDC's top priority is preserving the trust of the physicians and other healthcare providers who choose to share their data with the HDC network. HDC holds a Privacy By Design certification and adheres to the globally recognized privacy framework, allowing physicians to exercise autonomy, with accountability. Use of **HDC Discover** is offered at no cost to you or your practice, thanks to the sponsorship of the General Practice Services Committee (GPSC), a partnership between Doctors of BC and the Ministry of Health.

- Online registration takes only a few minutes.
- HDC's support team can walk you through the online registration process or you can do it yourself.
- After initial setup, ongoing data collection and transfer is automatic and rarely requires action from you or your team.

Joining HDC is a visible sign of your professional commitment to quality improvement.


